



## Inside-In Aalto Design Factory

Collaboration project on Future lab of product design (2007)

<u>Aalto Design Factory (ADF)</u> is an interdisciplinary product design and learning hub uniting students, teachers, researchers, and industry. We aim to build a new kind of passion-based learning culture for Aalto University.

**(DFGN)** is a network of 37 innovation hubs in 25 countries based in universities and research organisations






# EDUCATION

We welcomed hundreds of students and hosted almost two dozens of courses. Teachers in charge of the courses come from all the schools of Aalto, often joined by externals from other universities or industry partners.


### STUDY BACKGROUNDS

Most of the students coming to ADF this year were from ENG and SCI, however BIZ and ARTS students made up almost one third of all the students.



### STUDY LEVEL

We are trying to accomadate students' needs of all study levels and be as open as possible for all kinds of ideas, even if they seem crazy and too ambitious at first!



### COURSES

At ADF we proudly host a diverse range of dynamic courses that cater to the curious minds of tomorrow. The courses provide a unique blend of theory and practice, empowering participants to explore, experiment, and develop skills that extend beyond the classroom.



#### VISITING TEACHING

This year the members of the ADF research team has taught over 800 degree students and professionals in more than 200 hours of visiting lectures and workshops, enriching the Aalto community with interdisciplinary approach.


In *Cataly(c)st project* we wrapped up the Nordic Innovation funded joint project on supporting young change makers in advancing transitions to circular economy, a joint project with Aalto, with DTU (Denmark), KTH (Sweden), NTNU (Norway) and EFLA (Iceland).

#### TET STUDENTS

As every year, we welcomed more than 30 students from TET (Työelämään tutustuminen) program who enriched our community with new approaches and ideas. We had students from around 13 different schools and in total they spent 1200 hours working on projects.

# Outside-In IDBM Industry Project

One of Aalto University's flagship courses, the industry project provides a key learning platform of **interdisciplinary teamwork** and design thinking **in real-life industry projects**.

Lasting approximately **7 months**, the projects combine **multidisciplinary student teams with industrial/business partners** where students apply their skills on real-life business cases and problems.

Students receive travelling & prototyping budget.





## **Outside-Out** Aaltoes & Ignite



**Aaltoes is a student-run volunteer organization**, providing real-life entrepreneurial opportunities for curious individuals who want to challenge themselves and solve relevant challenges in an atmosphere where people default to action. Aaltoes has been pushing the cruciality of solving worldchanging problems through entrepreneurship in multiple programs and projects organised by driven students.

**Ignite is a 10-week accelerator** where first-time founders find their first customers and launch their businesses (if they haven't done it prior to the programme).

Participants receive:

- 1.5-5 k€ to launch your business over the summer
- Exclusive network with access to mentors, advisors and investors.
- 10 Credits (ECTS) –this programme is NOT only for Aalto students! ٠






# INCREDIT
