



General conditions for previous full (funded) partners

- **Any** organisation that has received funding in a cohort 1, 2 and 3 project **may** participate to the EIT HEI Initiative Call for Proposals 2024 as a full and/or associated partner.
- These 'previous' partners must take on a specific role within the consortium and the larger EIT HEI Initiative Community (which will always have a minimum of two HEIs new to the EIT HEI Initiative): Innovation and Entrepreneurship (I+E) Pioneer.
- As I+E Pioneers, you will **apply the I+E expertise and experience** gained through previous participation in the EIT HEI Initiative to:
 - Guide organisations new to the initiative
 - Transfer knowledge, successes and good practices
 - Expand and scale up your innovation capacity activities
- Funding from this 2024 Call **may not be used** for the simple **continuation/repetition of previously-funded activities**.











Guiding verbs for the I+E Pioneer role


1. Provide **support services/activities to the 'novice' HEI partners in the consortium**, helping them launch their innovation journey with the EIT HEI Initiative:

- Using expertise gained in previous cohorts, support novice partners to shape and improve their innovation strategies and policies and engage top management of all partners.
- **Guide** novice partners through the process of understanding the **HEInnovate self-assessment** results and **play a leading role** in the **effective selection of funded Actions** for the consortium.
- I+E Pioneer partners to deliver training and mentoring to novice partners in which they transfer I+E capacity building experience and expertise. Note: The KPI requirements may be used to drive this process!






• Register and engage with our <u>matchmaking tool</u>, **connecting novice partners to I&E pioneer HEI partners**



• **Support novice partners in the HEInnovate self-assessment process**, identifying I+E gaps and guiding the establishment of the project scope, the selection of the funded Actions, and the writing of a strong proposal







2. Share, **transfer** and **scale up good practices and project successes** from 'pioneer' partners to 'novice' partners, thereby **expanding** and **adapting** previous activities across the new consortium of partners.

e.g. Scale up a successful international alliance of TTOs set up during a previous project by incorporating the 'novice' partners into the alliance (meaning the establishment of new partnerships); I+E Pioneer partners to deliver key trainings to all TTO staff in the alliance on areas of tech transfer where expertise is lacking.

Recommendations:


- Where to look for more good practices and success stories:
 - EIT HEI Initiative <u>Resource Hub</u>
 - EIT HEI Initiative website <u>'Get inspired</u>' section
- Map all relevant I&E practices from 'I&E pioneers' partners ideally, at proposal writing stage. Based on the above mapping and your HEInnovate self-assessment results, decide what can/should be transferred in the context of the Call 2024 project scope/consortium.





3. Using the familiarity and experience of previous EIT HEI Initiative partners with the EIT Ecosystem, I+E Pioneer partners should lead the process of **exploring** and **pursuing additional opportunities and partnerships** available within the **EIT ecosystem** and within the **broader EU Funding landscape**

- Facilitate the consortium's participation in other EIT
 Community Initiatives or relevant EIT KIC activities
- Support consortium partners in the pursuit of the EIT Label certification to bring formal credibility to their I&E educational programs (degree programmes [master and doctoral] and non-degree programmes [professional education].



5. I+E Pioneers to take on an **ambassador role for the EIT HEI Initiative** at **relevant events** during the funding period and beyond, both internal and external events.

These include (but are not limited to):

- IVAP workshops
- Sensemaking workshops
- Co-creation workshops
- Alumni events
- Masterclass on diversity, equity and inclusion
- Systems innovation training
- Macro-regional conferences
- EIT HEI Initiative Community of Practice events
- EIT KIC Discovery Day
- EIT KIC events








6. I+E Pioneers to actively contribute to the EIT HEI Initiative **Alumni community and events**

- Responsible for ensuring that your project and beneficiaries of your project activities are engaging with the EIT HEI Initiative Alumni community and events, across the consortium
- Participating in EIT HEI Initiative alumni events as speakers or moderators
- Providing **insight and feedback** for creating an effective alumni community to the EIT HEI Initiative Alumni coordinators
- Taking on an **active role on the alumni platform**







- **7**. I+E Pioneers responsible for **engaging all project partners** in the consortium with the EIT HEI Initiative Community of Practice (CoP):
- Be the project contact point for the EIT HEI Initiative Community of Practice Manager, providing insights, support and feedback on behalf of the consortium for the creation of a strong EIT HEI Initiative CoP value proposition
- Take an active leadership role on the CoP platform and in CoP activities
